## Post-Secondary Students

### ENROLLMENT PROCEDURE

1. Students must take the entrance exam and score a level 4 on Applied Math and a level 4 on Reading for Information.
2. After passing the entrance exam at the required levels, please contact Teresa Vasquez at 785.670.3353 for upcoming class dates and times. Class is one semester. Enrollment is first-come, first served.
3. Students must have a valid/current C.N.A. license in Kansas.
4. **Fees must be paid in full at time of enrollment.** This course is not eligible for federal financial aid.

### OTHER NOTES

1. Students must be 18 years of age or older to take the state C.M.A. exam.
2. Students must take the state exam within one calendar year of the start date of their class.
3. If longer than one calendar year has passed, the student must re-take the entire C.M.A. class to be eligible to take the state exam.
4. Students are required to obtain a TB test; students should use the health care provider of their choice for this requirement.
5. Students will be required to purchase scrubs from the vendor of their choice. Prices will vary by vendor.
