

COMMERCIAL TRUCK DRIVING

This specialized training can lead to a variety of career options from driving a bus to hauling goods across the country. It is a short-term investment that can bring long-term benefits to any job seeker. Get on the road to a better future and enroll now at Washburn Tech.

Learning at Washburn Tech

This program begins with four days of interaction with the Kansas Department of Transportation, including a physical, drug screen and testing for instructional permits. Students will then spend time in the classroom and behind the wheel.

Classroom training covers federal motor carrier regulations, daily logs and equipment of the trade. Driving training includes inspections, range driving, defensive driving, basic road skills and backing skills.

In addition, students will hear presentations from several industry professionals, including placement

presentations with major trucking companies. Attending full-day, students can complete the course in six weeks. Students attending half-day can complete the course in one semester. Please note: this program is not financial aid eligible.

Job and Salary Outlook

Employment of heavy and tractor-trailer truck drivers is expected to grow by 11 percent during a 10-year period according to the Kansas Department of Labor (KDOL). As the economy grows, the demand for goods will increase and more truck drivers will be needed to keep supply chains moving.

KDOL lists the average entry-level salary in Shawnee County at \$19 an hour or \$39,520 annually. The wage for an experienced driver is \$30.87 an hour or \$64,200 annually.

Entry Requirements

Students are encouraged to have foundational knowledge. In addition, you must score a minimum of 4 in both Math and Reading on the ACT WorkKeys, complete an application and submit an official copy of transcripts.

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Course Descriptions

Commercial Truck Driving I:

this course incorporates the curricular recommendations of the U.S. Department of Transportation's Federal Highway Administration's Office of Motor Carriers Model curriculum; students will learn how to read and interpret control systems, perform vehicle inspections, exercise basic control, execute shifting, back and dock commercial motor vehicle, couple and uncouple trailer; perform visual search, manage and adjust vehicle speed, manage and adjust vehicle space relations, check and maintain vehicle systems and components, and diagnose and report malfunctions

Commercial Truck Driving II:

this course builds on Commercial Truck Driving I; students will learn how to identify potential driving hazards and perform emergency maneuvers, identify and adjust to difficult and extreme driving conditions, handle and document cargo, address accident scenes and report procedures, address environmental issues, plan trips, use effective communications, manage personal resources while on the road, and record and maintain hours of service requirements
