The Advanced Emergency Medical Technician (AEMT) program offers a flexible schedule to accomodate students currently working as EMTs. It prepares you to recognize, assess and manage medical emergencies in prehospital settings and to supervise ambulance personnel. For two semesters, students must attend two nights a week and one Saturday each month. Upon completion of the 20-credithour program, you will be prepared to take the AEMT exam. You must be 18 years old to take the course and the certification test.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Students are required to have already earned an EMT certificate and Basic Life Saving (BLS)certification. In addition, they must have a minimum score of 5 in Reading and Math on the Accuplacer exam **or** receive faculty/ director approval. Please see an admissions counselor for details. Students must complete an application, undergo a background check and submit an official copy of all transcripts. Certain immunizations, a medical exam and medical insurance also are required.

COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

ADVANCED EMT I: MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

This course addresses current information and techniques considered the responsibility of the AEMT according to the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration, National Standard Curriculum, as enriched by the KSBEMS Education Standards. It focuses on medical terminology, the human body, advanced patient assessment and advanced pharmacology. Topics include: didactic and practical skills instruction, skills demonstrations, clinical experience and/or orientation to the emergency room and to the ambulance, extrication class or in contrived experiences of patient care.

ADVANCED AEMT II: TRAUMA EMERGENCIES

This course is a continuation of the first course with focus on didactic and practical skills instruction, skills demonstrations, clinical experience and/or orientation to the emergency room and to the ambulance, extrication class, or in contrived experiences of patient care.

ADVANCED AEMT: FIELD INTERNSHIP I

This course will enable the student to have hands-on experience utilizing the knowledge and skills gained in the previous courses. The student will be supervised and evaluated by an assigned preceptor on the abilty to assess and manage traumatic and medical emergencies.

ADVANCED AEMT: FIELD INTERNSHIP II

This course builds on the previous course. Students will have hands-on experience utilizing the knowledge and skills gained. An assigned preceptor will supervise and evaluate on the abilty to assess and manage traumatic and medical emergencies. The student will be evaluated in the classroom, field and clinical setting.

Please note: Students must be at least 18 years of age to take this program. Financial aid is not available to students who enroll.
