WorkKeys is a job skills assessment system that helps employers select, hire, train, develop and retain a high-performance workforce. This series of tests measures foundational and soft skills and offers specialized assessments to target institutional needs. If you already have taken other exams, such as CASAS, ACT or COMPASS, find out whether you scored high enough to test out of a WorkKeys exam. In addition, you are required to type 25 net words per minute.
