



Summary of Scholarships Available

Spring Semester 2019

Deadlines to apply are as follows, unless otherwise noted in the description:

- **Final submission deadline for the spring semester is Friday, January 18, 2019.**
 - **Determination letters sent to applicants by Friday, February 15, 2019.**
- The number of scholarships available each semester is based on available funds and stipulations of the donor. Information provided in this summary may change at donor discretion and as funds increase or decrease.
- Incomplete applications will not be considered. Return your completed application including essay responses and recommendation forms. Different scholarships have different criteria; submit what is requested for the scholarship(s) you apply for.
- Scholarship Recognition/Disbursement date is March 7, 2019. If awarded a scholarship for spring semester, you will be invited and expected to attend the reception.
- **All scholarship are competitive.** Applications will be read and rated by teams of Tech staff. Students receiving the higher overall ratings will be awarded scholarships.

Who qualifies to apply: (Multiple scholarships will be awarded for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in one of the high-demand career programs listed below, as determined by the KS Dept. of Commerce: **Advanced Systems Technology, Automotive Service Technology, Building Technology, Climate & Energy, Commercial & Heavy Construction, Commercial Truck Driving, Culinary Arts, Diesel Technology, Electrical Technology, Emergency Communications, EMT, Heavy Diesel Technology, Information Systems Technology, Locomotive Diesel Technology, Phlebotomy, Practical Nursing (not pre-requisite courses), Machine/Tool Technology (Cert A and Cert C), Surgical Technology, Welding (Cert A and Cert C)**
- Shawnee County residents
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED) (high school students not eligible)
- New and continuing students
 - Continuing students must have a 3.0 or higher Grade Point Average (GPA) in the current program

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be a professional recommendation, such as a high school teacher, a Washburn Tech instructor, or a work supervisor. Recommendation forms from family members and friends will not be accepted.
- Award Amount
 - \$250 for students enrolled in 9 to 17 credit hours
 - \$500 for students enrolled 18 credit hours or more
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester is required. Students can apply for and be considered for more than 1 type of scholarship by using the same application/essay responses.
- If funds are available, this scholarship is automatically renewed for subsequent semesters within the same technical program; student must maintain good attendance and a cumulative program GPA of 3.0 or better

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one scholarship for spring semester)

- Students who provide verification of service in combat duty in a recognized conflict, combat, or war zone and submit a DD214 showing honorable discharge
- Students who completed at least one semester in current program and have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Instructor within current technical program
- Award amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Beaman Family Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award 2 scholarships for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Advanced Systems Technology, Building Technology, Cabinet/Millwork, Climate and Energy Control, Commercial and Heavy Construction, Electricity, Practical Nursing or Surgical Technology**
- Students who completed at least one semester in current program with a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Instructor within current technical program
- Award amount - \$1000
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Chartwell's Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award multiple scholarships for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Auto Collision, Business Bookkeeping and Accounting, Cosmetology, Early Childhood Education, Emergency Communications, Graphics Technology, Legal Office Professional, Medical Office Specialist, Technical Drafting**
- Students must have one completed semester in current program with a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better
- Post-secondary applicants must possess a high school diploma or GED
- High school students must be "on track" to graduate, per their high school counselor

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Instructor within the current technical program
- Award Amount
 - \$250 for students enrolled in 9 to 17 credit hours
 - \$500 for students enrolled 18 credit hours or more
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

KBS Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one high school scholarship and one post-secondary scholarship)

- Students enrolled in **Building Technology, Cabinet and Millwork, Climate and Energy Control, Commercial and Heavy Construction, or Electrical Technology**
- High school and post-secondary students
- New and continuing students
 - Continuing students must have a 3.0 GPA or better in the current technical program

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application, including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be a professional recommendation, such as a high school teacher, a Washburn Tech instructor, or a work supervisor. Recommendation forms from family members and friends will not be accepted.
- Award Amount - \$250
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- **If funds are available, scholarship is automatically renewed for one subsequent semester for students who maintain a Washburn Tech cumulative GPA of 3.0 or better and remain in the same technical program**

Rita C. and Paul B. Etzel Scholarship Fund

Who qualifies to apply: (Four scholarships will be awarded for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Practical Nursing, Surgical Technology, Commercial and Heavy Construction, Diesel Technology**
- Students with one completed full- day semester
- Preference is given to non-traditional students with minor, dependent children.

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application, including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be a professional recommendation, such as a high school teacher, a Washburn Tech instructor, or a work supervisor. Recommendation forms from family members and friends will not be accepted.
- Award Amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Yingling Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one scholarship spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Automotive Service Technician or Auto Collision**
- Students with one completed semester in current program with a cumulative program GPA of 2.5 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Instructor in your current technical program
- Award Amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Daniel Kelley Memorial Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one scholarship spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Diesel Technology or Heavy Diesel Technology**
 - Students enrolled in the Diesel Locomotive program are not eligible for this scholarship
- Students with one completed semester in current program with a cumulative program GPA of 3.0 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Diesel Instructor
- Award Amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Lenn Hunter Memorial Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one scholarship)

- Students enrolled in the final semester of the **Surgical Technology** program
- Students who have a cumulative program GPA of 3.0 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from a Washburn Tech Surgical Tech Instructor (classroom or clinical)
- Award Amount - \$1000
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester

Ed Bozarth Chevrolet #1 Buick GMC, Inc. Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award two scholarships)

- Students enrolled in the final semester of the **Automotive Service Technician** program
- Students with a cumulative program GPA of 3.0 or better
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from one of the Washburn Tech Automotive Instructors
- Award amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Top ranked applicants will have a personal interview with scholarship donor
 - Scholarship donor will make final selections after interviews

William T. Goff Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one post-secondary and one high school scholarship for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in **Welding – Cert C – 48 credit hour**
 - Students enrolled in the Welding – Cert A program are **not** eligible for this scholarship
- Students with one completed semester in welding with a cumulative program GPA of 2.75 or better and 90% or better attendance rate
- High school and post-secondary students
 - High school students must submit a high school transcript with a GPA of 2.5 or higher

Details and how to apply:

- Complete General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be from an instructor in the 48 credit hour welding program
- Award Amount
 - \$500 – post-secondary recipient
 - \$250 – high school recipient
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Locomotive Diesel Technology – NARS - Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Multiple scholarships may be awarded spring semester)

- Students in **Locomotive Diesel Technology who are enrolled in the NARS curriculum**
- High school and post-secondary students

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form
 - Must be a professional recommendation, such as a high school teacher, a Washburn Tech instructor, or a work supervisor. Recommendation forms from family members and friends will not be accepted.
- Award amount – Post-secondary, \$1500; High school, \$1,000
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Washburn Tech Practical Nursing Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award one scholarship for spring semester)

- Students enrolled in the **final semester** of the Practical Nursing program
 - Day or Evening
- Students who have earned all A's and B's within the Practical Nursing program; pre-requisite course grades are not considered
- Post-secondary students (must have a high school diploma or GED)

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 2 recommendation forms
 - Must be from instructors who taught the first portion of the Practical Nursing program at Washburn Tech; one from a classroom instructor and one from a clinical instructor
- Award amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester

Phlebotomy Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (Will award 4 scholarships for spring semester)

- Post-secondary students

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Award amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester

Phlebotomy Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply:

- High School and Post-Secondary students who are determined to have financial need.
- Postsecondary students must complete the fafsa using the following website: www.fafsa.ed.gov.
- High school students must submit documentation from their high school verifying they are eligible for free or reduced lunch and textbooks.

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Award amount - \$534 for post-secondary student; \$144 for high school students
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one per semester

Eldon Gideon Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (One scholarship will be awarded spring semester)

- Must be Seaman high school graduate (no specific date of graduation)
- **Post-secondary student** enrolled in one of the following programs: **Advanced Systems Technology, Auto Collision, Auto Service Tech, Building Tech, Cabinet/Millwork, Climate & Energy, Commercial & Heavy Construction, Diesel Tech, Electrical Tech, Heavy Diesel Tech, Information Systems Tech, Machine Tool (48 credit program), Tech Drafting**
- No record of participation in any extracurricular competitive sport while in high school (donor requires verification from Seaman High School administration)
- Must have one completed semester in one of the programs listed above

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a General Scholarship Application including responses to essay questions
- Submit 1 recommendation form; must be completed by an instructor within your technical program
- Award amount - \$500
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, submit only one packet per semester
- Scholarship is not renewable for subsequent semesters

Bryden Scholarship

Who qualifies to apply: (As funds are available, multiple scholarships may be awarded)

- High school students who are eligible for free/reduced lunch at their home high school
- New and continuing students
 - Continuing students must have an overall Washburn Tech GPA of 2.50 or better

Details and how to apply:

- Complete a Bryden Scholarship Application
- Provide documentation from the high school regarding eligibility for free or reduced lunch
- Award amount - \$100
- Submit application packet to the Washburn Tech Financial Aid Office located in the Student Services Office, only one packet per semester
- Applications for this semester are accepted throughout the semester, if funds remain available
- Scholarship is not automatically renewable for subsequent semesters
- Prior semester balance must be paid in full
